CONTENTS

Your Mosaic is supplied in one box containing:

- 1 x grid board
- 4 x bags of squares (350 in total, 12 colours)

BEFORE USE

1. Unpack and dispose of the plastic bags holding the squares.
2. Keep the box for storage.
3. Find a flat and stable surface to work on.

SUGGESTIONS FOR USE

Colour Recognition

Ask your client to use only squares of a certain colour. Increase the difficulty by introducing a second colour, then a third ...

Counting Skills

Encourage your client to use a specific amount of squares to encourage early counting.

Symmetry

If you create a pattern on one half of the grid, can your client produce a mirror image of the pattern on the other side?

Pattern Replication

Take a few moments to place a pattern on the grid board. Photograph the pattern and print this out. Ask your client to make the same pattern. Create patterns according to the ability of your clients. Alternatively, more able clients may be able to follow written or verbal instructions e.g. make a large blue square, make a large yellow rectangle, make a red diamond, make a tree etc. Can the client 'copy' an object from a photograph or picture e.g. a flower?

Describing Skills

Encourage language skills by asking your client to talk about what they are creating. What adjectives can they use to describe their art? Encourage understanding of prepositions – the red square is above the blue one ... next to the yellow one etc.

SAFETY

1. Always supervise the use of this product.
2. The squares are small and should never be placed in the mouth.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. Wipe clean with a soft and slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the pieces together in the box provided to avoid losing any pieces.
